

Travelling By Car

10 free parking spaces available for patients/participants attending for an appointment in the CRC.



- Car park is directly in front of the CRC.
- A parking space must be reserved otherwise you may not be able to park if it's full.
- Call 01382 632287 to reserve a space.

Ninewells Hospital main car parks cost £2.00



- 1. Turn into Ninewells Drive
- 2. Drive until you see the Teddy Bear nursery on the right hand side.
- 3. Across from the nursery on the left hand side you will see James Arrott Drive.
- 4. Drive straight down James Arrott Drive until you see a car park barrier on the left hand side.
- 5. Press the CRC button on the barrier.
- 6. The receptionist will ask your name and then raise the barrier.
- 7. Please keep a note of the CRC car park bay number and give this to the receptionist.
- 8. The exit barrier will lift automatically as you leave.



- 1. At the end of Charleston Drive, turn left into Ninewells Drive. This road takes you along the back of the main hospital car parks.
- 2. You will come to a pedestrian crossing at car park 9.
- 3. Once you are passed the pedestrian crossing, on the right is the entrance to the multi storey car park and then next is James Arrott Drive.
- 4. Drive straight down James Arrott Drive until you see a car park barrier on the left hand side.
- 5. Press the CRC button on the barrier.
- 6. The receptionist will ask your name and then raise the barrier.
- 7. Please keep a note of the CRC car park bay number and give this to the receptionist.
- 8. The exit barrier will lift automatically as you leave.

Travelling by Bus

DO NOT enter the main hospital entrance.

When you come off the bus at Ninewells Hospital there is a free shuttle bus that will bring you around to the CRC. This is located at the top of the main bus stop area behind the glass.

Walking from the bus

Walk (approximately 5/10 minutes) from the main bus stations, along the footpath, following the signs for the Clinical Research Centre. Go down the **flight of steps** between the multi storey car park and the TORT (Tayside Orthopaedic and Rehabilitation) building. Proceed with care down the steps and then through the blue gate. Turn right and proceed to the pedestrian crossing, where you can cross the road please take care. The CRC is directly in front of you.

Alternatively you may use the **multi storey car park i.e. Car Park 8** which is located on Ninewells Drive. To get to the CRC from here, there is a flight of steps (on the left when you come out of the car park) leading down between the multi storey car park and TORT Centre. Proceed with care down the steps and then through the blue gate. Turn right and proceed to the pedestrian crossing, where you can cross the road to the CRC - please take care.

If you park in any of the other hospital car parks, please DO NOT go to the main hospital entrance. Instead you should make your way, by footpath, to the multi-storey car park/TORT Centre and follow the directions from there as described in the above paragraph.

Please note that you may use the **courtesy mini-bus** from the **main hospital entrance**, **Car Park 9** or the **TORT Centre/Car Park 8**. Please ask the driver to stop at the CRC. This service runs approximately every 15 minutes, between 9am and 5pm,
